Kunyanja School has continued to provide a great education to 300 children as well as adults returning to night school to complete their studies.

Some highlights of 2012

- Sydney Simumba, one of the founding teachers of Kunyanja School, graduated top of his class at university and has returned as headmaster.

- Completing a school hall, creating a fantastic venue both for the school and the wider community.

Over the next year we will continue to support :

- Bursaries for 40-50 students so Kunyanja School can serve the whole community.
- 3 students at university.
- The development of the Kunyanja Trust, including income generation projects to help the school be sustainable into the future.
- Enriching school life through support from volunteers from the UK, and research trips for staff.
