Kunyanja School is growing from strength to strength with over 250 children and over 100 adults at night school completing their education. The school had fantastic exam results this year and many exciting things are on the horizon for 2014.



The Kunyanja Campus has become an amazing site. 4 classrooms, 2 science labs, a library, a hall, staff rooms and a garden.

During 2013, with your generous donations, we have supported: a bursary scheme for more than 40 children, 3 students at university, the completion of the school hall, the piggery, school garden, uniform project, a new project manager for the Trust, and a wonderful volunteer from the UK.
